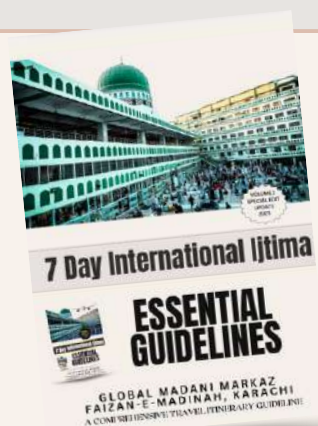

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Preparations in Your Home Country

1.1 REGISTRATION & PERSONAL ACCOUNT ACCESS

Your registration for the Ijtima is now completed via the official portal: <https://iad-event.dibaadm.com/registration>
This portal is your personal account and will serve as the central hub for all essential information, including:

- Schedules
- Important announcements
- Exclusive discounts (e.g., on 📖 books and 🩺 medical tests)

And Your attendance may also be managed through this account.

Please ensure you regularly check your personal account for updates.



1.2 PACKING ESSENTIALS

Create a comprehensive packing list to ensure you bring all necessary items. Remember to pack chargers and appropriate adapters for Pakistan's electrical outlets (**Type C, D, and F, 230V**). The weather in Karachi during November is generally pleasant, ranging from **20°C to 30°C (68°F to 86°F)**, so pack light, comfortable clothing suitable for warm days and mild evenings. Also note that many Essential items like Jubba, ready-made clothes, perfume (itar), prayer caps, and basic toiletries will also be available for purchase within Faizan-e-Madinah.

SPIRITUAL PREPARATION

We encourage you to engage in spiritual preparation for the Ijtimā. Consider keeping digital copies of the Holy Quran, Islamic booklets, or magazines to read as you may get time during your journey and stay(s).

PASSPORT & VISA REQUIREMENTS

Ensure your passport is valid for at least 06 months beyond your intended departure date from Pakistan. It is your responsibility to obtain the necessary visa for entry into Pakistan. Please apply for your visa well in advance, considering processing times.

TRAVEL RESERVATIONS

Double-check and confirm all your travel reservations, including flights, trains, or buses, and any transit accommodations required for your journey to Karachi. You can update your travel details and expected arrival time within your personal account.

ESSENTIAL TRAVEL DOCUMENTS

Make 03 or multiple copies (physical and digital) of all critical travel documents, including your passport, visa, flight tickets, and Ijtimā registration confirmation. Keep these copies separate from your originals and consider storing digital copies on a cloud service or secure email.

1.7 LUGGAGE SECURITY

Ensure all your luggage is in good condition, clearly labeled with your name and contact information, and secured with locks or straps for added safety during transit.



1.8 Emergency Contacts

Share your detailed travel itinerary and contact information with a trusted family member or friend in your home country. Keep a list of emergency contact numbers readily accessible, including local contacts in Pakistan if available.



1.9 TRAVEL APPS & NAVIGATION

Download essential travel applications for navigation, translation, and local information. Your destination in Karachi is Faizan-e-Madinah, University Road.



1.10 PERSONAL SAFETY

Always keep your personal belongings secure and exercise caution, especially in unfamiliar surroundings.



1.11 TRAVEL VACCINATIONS & HEALTH PRECAUTIONS

Adhere to all local and international health and safety guidelines. Consult your doctor well in advance of your travel date regarding any recommended vaccinations or health precautions for Pakistan. Some vaccines may require multiple doses or time to build immunity. Remember to put prescribed medicines in your bag.

During Your Journey to Global Madani Markaz



2.1 AIRPORT CHECK-IN

Check in for your flight either online (if available) or at your airline's counter at the airport. Be aware of your airline's specific check-in procedures and baggage drop-off times. Ensure you are in the correct queue for your flight.



2.2 SECURITY SCREENING

Fully cooperate with airport security staff. Ensure all liquids and gels, if in your carry-on luggage, comply with international regulations (typically 100ml containers in a clear, resealable bag). All electronic devices containing batteries should be carried in your hand luggage.



2.3 CARRY-ON & CHECKED LUGGAGE

Ensure your checked luggage is clearly tagged with your name and contact information. Always keep essential items such as medications, important documents, and valuables in your carry-on bag.



2.4 GATE INFORMATION

Regularly check the airport departure boards or screens for the most up-to-date information regarding your flight's gate and boarding time.



2.5 PERSONAL COMFORT & REFRESHMENTS

Stay well-hydrated throughout your journey, especially during long flights or layovers. You may carry non-perishable snacks and fruits for personal consumption, adhering to airline and customs regulations.



2.6 CURRENCY EXCHANGE (PRE-TRAVEL)

While ATMs and currency exchange facilities are available at Jinnah International Airport (Karachi) and within Faizan-e-Madinah, it is highly recommended to exchange a small amount of your local currency into major international currencies (e.g., USD, GBP, EUR) before departing your home country. Ensure the notes are clean and in good condition to avoid any inconvenience during exchange.

3.1 BAGGAGE CLAIM

Upon arrival at Jinnah International Airport, proceed to the baggage claim area to collect your checked luggage. Please double-check to ensure you have all your belongings before exiting.

3.2 LOCAL CURRENCY EXCHANGE

If you need to exchange more currency upon arrival, you can use the services at Jinnah International Airport or the facilities available within Faizan-e-Madinah if you have major currencies and clear notes.



3.3 AIRPORT TRANSPORTATION TO FAIZAN-E-MADINAH

If your registration and travel details were submitted on time via the personal account, you will be informed if transportation from Jinnah International Airport, Karachi, has been arranged for you. You can also indicate your need for pick-up or confirm your independent travel plans within your personal account. If you have not received such confirmation or need to arrange your own transport, we recommend using a reputable taxi service like "White Cab" or a ride-hailing service like Uber or Careem. Your destination is Faizan-e-Madinah, University Road, Karachi. In case of any confusion upon arrival, please contact the Ijtima Welcome Desk at +92 310 5709212.

3.4 ARRIVAL & WELCOMING

Upon your arrival at Faizan-e-Madinah, you will pass through a security check at the main gate. Our welcoming team will greet you, guide you to your accommodation, and provide you with the initial schedule of events.



3.5 AMANAT (VALUABLES) DESK

For your peace of mind, we strongly recommend depositing your valuables, such as your passport, extra cash, and other important documents, at the secure Amanat Desk. This service is provided to ensure the safety of your belongings. It is advisable not to carry large amounts of cash or unnecessary legal documents with you.

3.6 IJTIMA SCHEDULE & MEETINGS



The detailed schedule for the Ijtimia will be provided upon your arrival and updated regularly. If you wish to arrange a meeting with any department or a Rukn-e-Shoora, please coordinate with the International Affairs Department to schedule it outside of the official Ijtimia sessions. We recommend extending your stay if you anticipate needing several important meetings.

3.6.1 TENTATIVE HIGH-LEVEL SCHEDULE FOR IJTIMA 2025:

- *Dates: [25 November - 01 December, 2025]*
- *Key Sessions: The Ijtimia will feature invaluable training sessions on organizational skills, character development, and spiritual growth, led by Ameer-e-Ahl-e-Sunnat (دامت برکاتہم العالیہ), Nigran-e-Shoora, honorable Muftis, and other esteemed preachers.*
- *Special Events: Participants will have the blessed opportunity to attend special gatherings with Ameer-e-Ahl-e-Sunnat, the Successor to Ameer-e-Ahl-e-Sunnat, and Nigran-e-Shoora. This includes a special dinner and exclusive Q&A sessions.*
- *Daily Routine: The daily schedule will include reformative Bayans, organizational training, sessions on Sunnah and manners, and visits to various departments. Approximately 7 to 7.5 hours will be allocated for sleep.*

3.7 ACCOMMODATION & BASIC NEEDS



Designated sleeping areas will be organized by region, and your specific sleeping location will be displayed at the venue and also appear in your personal account on the registration portal. A mattress, pillow, and blanket will be provided for your rest. Washroom and toilet facilities are conveniently located. You may bring your own pillow if you have specific needs. A list of essential items available for purchase within Faizan-e-Madinah will be provided closer to the event date.

Luggage Storage: *A secure, designated luggage storage area will be provided with organized racks. Each country will have its specific allocated space for luggage storage. This area will be secured to ensure the safety of your belongings.*

3.8 REGISTRATION CARD & IJTIMA ID

Upon arrival and check-in, you will be issued an official Ijtima registration card. This card will serve as your ID for accessing your accommodation and designated training areas. The cards will be color-coded for different categories of participants (e.g., guests, management). We also recommend keeping a notepad and pen to take notes during the sessions.



3.9 SAFETY & SECURITY



Always secure your personal belongings and valuables within your accommodation. Use small locks on your hand luggage and checked bags. If you need to leave the premises of Faizan-e-Madinah, you must inform the International Affairs Office and register your departure at the exit gate.

3.10 FOOD & DINING

Nutritious meals will be provided at designated dining areas and times within Faizan-e-Madinah. We strongly advise against consuming outside food, as it may not meet hygiene standards and could adversely affect your health.



3.11 INTERNET & CONNECTIVITY

To facilitate your connectivity, a dedicated team will assist you in obtaining a data-only SIM card for internet access. Please note these SIMs are not for voice calls. A single Pakistani ID (CNIC) can facilitate up to 7 data SIMs for foreign visitors. If your mobile phone is not registered with the Pakistan Telecommunication Authority (PTA), the SIM may only function temporarily. Additionally, free Wi-Fi internet access may be available at specific locations for limited hours.



3.12 MEDICAL FACILITY

A dedicated medical facility with qualified staff is available on-site 24/7 within Faizan-e-Madinah. If you feel unwell or require any medical attention, please inform the management or the Feedback/Complaint Desk immediately, or contact +92 334 6156956. It is crucial to report any health concerns promptly rather than waiting or self-medicating. Specific contact numbers for management and support will also be available within your personal account.



3.13 ATTENDANCE & MOVEMENT

Punctual attendance in all scheduled sessions is mandatory to gain the full spiritual and educational benefits of the Ijtimah. If you need to leave a session or the premises of Faizan-e-Madinah, you must inform the management. We strongly advise against leaving the premises unless absolutely necessary and with prior approval. You may use your personal account to report your location or for attendance tracking if instructed to use the application for this purpose (This phase is under development in the application).



3.14 FEEDBACK & SUPPORT DESK

A dedicated Feedback and Support Desk will be available to address any problems, questions, or suggestions you may have. You can also contact our permanent support number at +92 311 4994126 anytime, from anywhere, for complaints and suggestions.

3.16 DOMESTIC TRAVEL & TICKETING

For your convenience, a Ticketing Department is available at the International Affairs Office to assist with purchasing domestic travel tickets (airlines, train, bus, etc.) within Pakistan. You may contact them at +92 315 2687866 between 12:00 PM and 4:00 PM (Pakistan Local Time). You can also report your departure from Faizan-e-Madinah and your expected return time via your personal account.



3.17 EXTENDED STAY

If you wish to extend your stay at Faizan-e-Madinah beyond the Ijtimah dates (e.g., after December 2nd), please inform the International Affairs Office in advance. They will assist in preparing your schedule and updating your arrangements. You may contact them at +92 310 5709212. You can also report your extended stay plans directly within your personal account (please report it in the beginning).



3.18 TRANSLATION SERVICES

For the 2025 Ijtimah, live translation services will be available. We plan to offer a live commentary system in English. For other languages, AI-translated commentary will be displayed on dedicated screens to provide the context of the speeches. Please inquire at the registration desk for details on available languages and access methods.



3.19 INFORMATION FOR ISLAMIC SISTERS

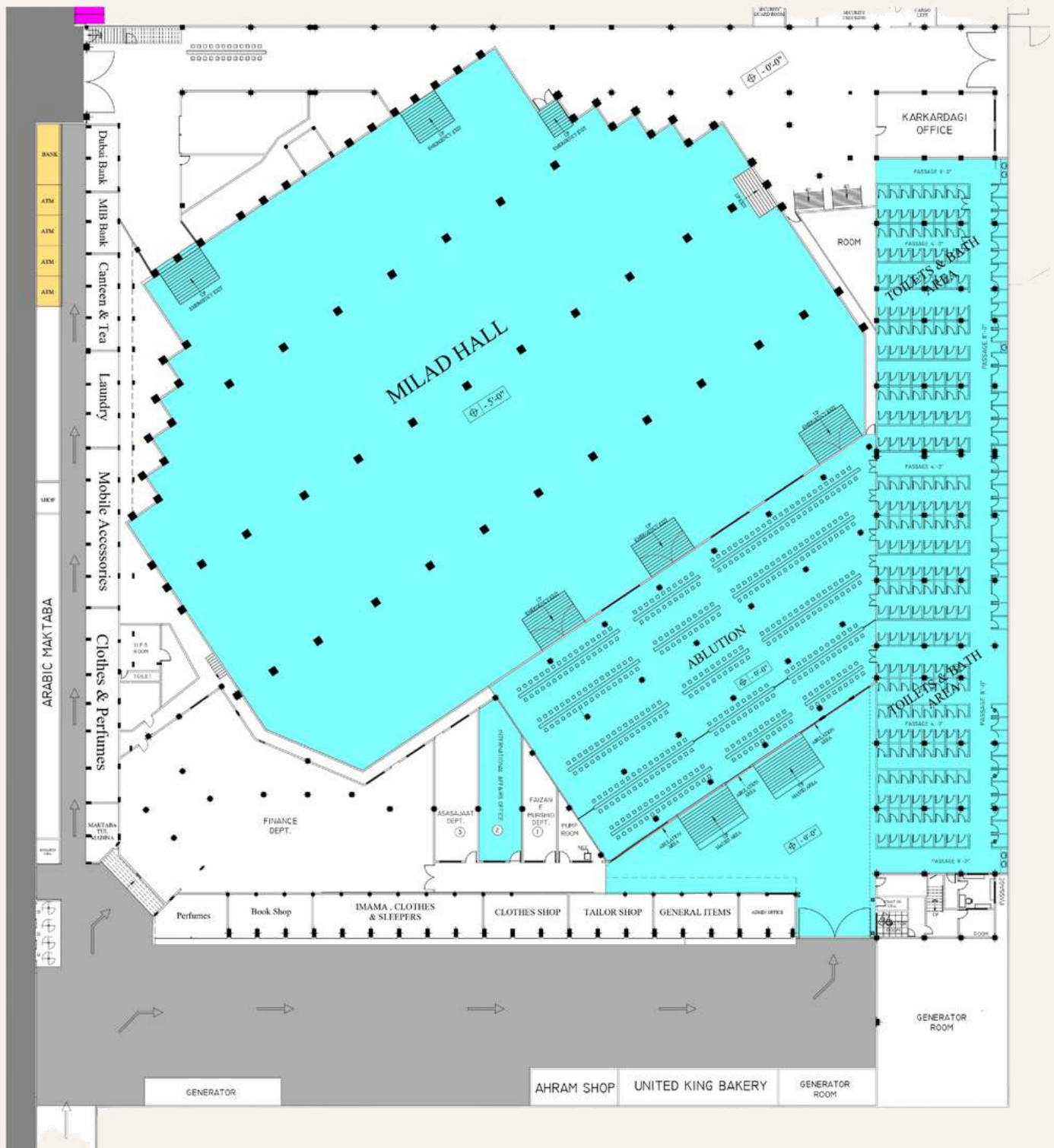
